Dearborn high school students will remove snow from your front walkway and driveway.

Dearborn Snow Removal Program Guidelines

- 1. You must be a resident of Dearborn and provide a copy of your driver's license or state I.D. when registering.
- 2. You must be at least 60 years old or disabled.
- 3. Snow will be removed from the front of the home, walkway and driveway.
- 4. Snow removal is dependent on the number of students available. There is no guarantee your snow will be shoveled on the day of the snowfall.
- 5. Students will not be allowed to do any other tasks. Nor will they be allowed to enter your home or garage. They will not be able to remove snow from your car.
- 6. Students will use their own equipment.
- 7. An Eligibility Form must be filled out, before students will be assigned to your home.
