General Pool Rules

- 1. No swinging on rope/lane markers or climbing/hanging on features.
- 2. No diving backwards or back flips off diving board. You must jump straight forward off the end of the board.
- 3. No hanging on the walls of the lazy river or the vortex.
- 4. No spinning down the slide. You must go down on your back, feet first, with your hands crossed across your chest the whole way.
- 5. No hanging on head, neck or shoulders of other patrons.
- 6. To use the lap lanes patrons must be 18 years of age or older or have a lap card.
- 7. Absolutely no running at any time in the pool area or pool terrace.
- 8. Fighting, wrestling, horseplay, pushing, punching, kicking and any like activities are not allowed at the Ford Community and Performing Arts Center and may result in ejection from the Center and possible suspension of member privileges.
- 9. Inflatables and pool toys are not allowed in the pool area.
- 10. Swim lesson toys and inflatables are for swim lessons, special events and instructors only.
- 11. Children under age 10 require supervision by a responsible adult at all times. The adult must accompany the child at all times including in the water.
- 12. Food and drinks are not allowed in the pool area or on the pool terrace (except water).
- 13. Goggles are permitted in the pool but must only cover the eyes and not cover the nose. Goggles are not permitted on the diving board or on the slide.
- 14. Fins and snorkels are only allowed with aquatic administration approval.
- 15. Swearing will not be tolerated.
- 16. Swimmers must wear appropriate swim attire to use the pool. Please refer to the apparel policy.
- 17. Use of tobacco, alcohol, vapes, and/or illegal substances is not permitted at any time.
- 18. No street shoes are allowed on the pool deck as it is a state law. Shoes that are specifically for pool deck use are allowed.
- 19. Obey pool staff at ALL times.
- 20. Only U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejackets are allowed.
