## Following the simple rules below will ensure the safety and enhance enjoyment for all facility users:

- 1. For safety reasons, the lifeguard controls the pool. They may ask a patron to leave for exhibiting dangerous, inappropriate or obnoxious behavior.
- 2. The lifeguard may request a demonstration of swimming ability and place a person in a safe swimming area.
- 3. Walk at all times.
- 4. Vulgar or abusive language is prohibited (this includes swearing).
- 5. Only U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejackets are allowed.
- 6. Only appropriate front jumps and surface dives are allowed in water greater than 7ft. deep.
- 7. Sitting or hanging on lane markers or lifelines is prohibited.
- 8. Swim lanes are for adults 18+ and lap card holders.
- 9. Do not play with jets or anodes in any pool.
- 10. Rescue equipment is for official use only.
- 11. Cigarettes, chewing tobacco, and vapes are prohibited in and around the pool area.
- 12. Alcohol and drugs are not allowed in or around the pool area. Intoxicated individuals will not be allowed in the facility.
- 13. Glass, soap, lotion, oil, gum, food and beverages other than water are not allowed in the pool area.
- 14. Children under age 10 require supervision by a responsible adult at all times.

## **STATE LAWS**

- 1. Any person who has an infectious or communicable disease shall be excluded from the swimming pool.
- 2. Persons using the pools shall take showers before entering the pool area.
- 3. Swimming apparel worn in the pool shall be clean (See apparel Policy).
- 4. Spitting or otherwise polluting the pools or deck area is prohibited.
- 5. Running, boisterous or rough play is not permitted in the pool area or bathhouse.
- 6. Persons in street clothes and/or shoes are not permitted in a swimming pool.
