Why is it important to have a strategic plan?

A city strategic plan is a roadmap that outlines the community's longterm vision, priorities, and goals. It serves as a guide for decision-making and resource allocation, ensuring that the city's growth and development align with the needs and aspirations of its residents. It helps address challenges, identify opportunities, and foster collaboration among residents, businesses, and local government. It is also an opportunity for greater government transparency and accountability.

Were community members involved in creating the plan?

Community input was central to the strategic planning process. The Mayor and City officials attended town halls, neighborhood association meetings, and other public forums to collect comprehensive notes on the ideas, concerns, and aspirations of Dearborn's residents. A community survey was also distributed to gather broader feedback. Additionally, City officials met directly with residents and community groups, and carefully tracked concerns and questions that came through the City's Response Center. The City worked hand-in-hand with directors and staff across all departments to identify priorities and ensure the plan reflects the needs and values of Dearborn residents.

What are the key components of the strategic plan?

Annual updates will be shared with the community and adjustments will be made as needed to address changing circumstances. The City administration will oversee the implementation of the plan and ensure that resources are allocated efficiently in accomplishing these objectives.

How will the City keep residents updated on the progress of the strategic plan?

The City will provide an annual update on the progress of the plan, including where it stands with identified goals and metrics. The strategic plan is designed to be a living document, meaning it can evolve throughout the implementation process. What is the difference between a city strategic plan and a master land use plan?




