Director's Report

Jon Golich gave the Director's Report.

Putting Dearborn Hills to bed for the winter went very well. Going to council for approval to purchase two mowers which will help keep course maintenance in-house. Have hired a green specialist to temporarily work on the course greens and teach staff green maintenance.

Fitness Area – Fitness area is looking fantastic. Going with two memberships for the Fitness areamonthly and yearly. Goal is to get back to \$1,000,000 in memberships. Feel pricing is very competitive with gyms in the area. Have Silver Sneaker enrollment available. Looking for a lot a specials and promotions during the coming year. Encouraged Commission to share information on the Fitness area on social media. Not having a Black Friday sale did not have a significant impact. Still have fee assistance program and one staff member is dedicated to that. Receive about 30-40 fee assistance requests per year. No longer have corporate memberships, with memberships being resident and non-resident.
