- **MCOLES Grant** \$180,000 to reimburse training costs for nine police officers.
- Wayne County Resilience HUB Grant \$99,272 for Fire Department emergency management support.
- University of Michigan—Dearborn and The Henry Ford donated \$20,000 each towards the implementation of the FUSUS platform.

Awarded Contract/Bid/Proposal/Purchase to

- Lutz Roofing Co. \$679,470 (+5% contingency) for roof replacements at Fire Stations 1–4.
- **MacQueen Emergency** \$43,784 for replacement firetruck equipment.
- **Central Square** \$617,953 for a new 911 Dispatch Phone System, plus fund transfer authorization.
- **Celeste Kettenah** \$42,000 contract as Health Communications Specialist for Public Health.
