Contract Summary for Morrow Circle Water Main Replacement & Street Resurfacing

Water Main Replacement & Street Resurfacing 2023, Phase III The attach contract with Eminent Excavating, Inc. is for the water main replacement and street resurfacing for Morrow Circle located on Dearborn's northeast side. The work will take place between Tireman and Esper Blvd. This project will also contain a bioretention element that will be funded with CDBG-DR funds. Bioretention is a stormwater management technique where landscaped and vegetated depressions capture and slow the flow of stormwater, which allows the water to be taken up by plants and seep into the ground. Bioretention cells, or rain gardens, are the landscaped and vegetated depressions that capture and filter stormwater runoff. These bioretention cells will be located in the right-of-way, between the curb and sidewalk, at various points along Morrow Circle. This project is a part of our Action Plan's green infrastructure projects that will be implemented on streets and to areas that were the most impacted and severely flooded during the 2021 storm, which are overwhelmingly found on the northeast and southeast areas of Dearborn.
