## **Dearborn City Council Meeting Summary - May 6, 2025**

### **Recognized**

- **Dearborn Exchange Club:** Recognized for its 100-year anniversary of service to the community.
- **Senior Volunteers of the Year:** Larry Kliemann and Kathleen Rock honored for their contributions to fellow senior residents.
- **National Nurses Week (May 6-12):** Recognized in appreciation of nurses' service and dedication.

### **Approved/Accepted**

- **First Reading: Water & Sewer Rates:** Introduced ordinance with 3.3% rate increase effective July 1, 2025.
- **First Reading: Food Truck Ordinance Update:** Introduced changes aligning with new zoning regulations.
- **First Reading: Vital Records Fees:** Introduced ordinance updating fees and eligibility for birth/death certificates.
- **Dearborn Summer Market:** Authorized Road/garage closures and noise waivers for summer market and movie nights.
- **Porch Replacement Program:** Approved 5-year SOQ list of contractors, max \$160,000 annually.

### **Awarded Contract/Bid/Proposal/Purchase**

- **Street Sweeper Rental:** Approved \$624,000 rental contract with MacQueen Group for 8 Elgin sweepers; return of \$625,754 to General Fund.
- **Storm Tunnel Rehab:** Awarded \$686,143 contract to Applied Science, Inc. for Colson Palmer Tunnel project.

- **Street/Sidewalk Repairs:** Approved \$3.1 million contract to Eminent Contracting for 2025 work.
- **Pavement Marking:** Approved \$292,957.80 contract with P.K. Contracting for road markings.
- **Rx Kids Program:** Accepted \$1 million federal grant to launch unconditional cash aid for new mothers and infants in Dearborn.
