Dearborn City Council Meeting Summary - Oct. 21, 2025

Recognized

- **The Pink Sisters:** Honoring their nonprofit support work for women with breast cancer.
- **Mary Petlichkoff:** For years of civic leadership on the Dearborn Public Schools Board, Henry Ford College Board, and other civic roles.
- **Michigan Library Appreciation Month:** October 2025 recognized in celebration of public, school, academic, and special libraries & contributions.
- **Breast Cancer Awareness Month:** Declared October 2025 as a month to support awareness, research, and early detection efforts.

Approved/Accepted

- **State and Local Cybersecurity Grant** - in the amount of \$475,000 for IT training for enhanced cybersecurity.
- **FEMA AFG Regional Grant**- in the amount of \$361,000 to purchase powered stair chairs for Dearborn and Detroit Fire Departments.
- **FEMA AFG Grant**- in the amount of \$266,541 to provide firefighter training and cancer screenings.
- **SMART Municipal Transit Contract FY2026** - in the amount of \$379,605.91 to support senior/disabled transportation services.
- **Ford World Headquarters Grand Opening Event**- Sunday, November 16, 2025
- **Firefighter Memorial at Station 2**- Approved the land use at 19800 Outer Drive in partnership with One Dearborn 501(c)(3) for memorial honoring fallen and disabled firefighters.
- **Drone Shows at Camp Dearborn Holiday Light Festival**- Dates: Nov 12, Nov 26, Dec 10, Dec 19



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Dearborn City Council Meeting Summary Continued **Oct. 21, 2025**

Awarded Contract/Bid/Proposal/Purchase to:

- **Dearborn Hills Golf Course Irrigation Pond Dredging** - Awarded to Muck-Men, in the amount of \$119,500 to remove sediment, stabilize pond banks, install new irrigation intake, and restore vegetation.
- **Dearborn Hills Golf Course Irrigation System Replacement** - Awarded to Fuse It Piping, LLC in the amount of \$449,500 to replace an obsolete irrigation system for modern water efficiency and long-term maintenance.
- **Security Camera Installation** – at Bryant Library awarded to D/A Central in the amount of \$73,565.
- **Stryker Powered Stair Chairs for EMS** - in the amount of \$412,576, to purchase 38 powered stair chairs and accessories for EMS transport and firefighter injury prevention.
- **EMS Billing Services Extension** - awarded to EMS Management & Consultants in the amount of \$738,181 (5 years) to continue EMS and fire cost recovery billing services.
