**TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF DEARBORN:**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that any qualified elector of the City of Dearborn who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the City Clerk; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at [www.mi.gov/vote](http://www.mi.gov/vote) and mailed to the City Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at [www.expressSOS.com](http://www.expressSOS.com).

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the City Clerk is **Monday, July 20, 2026**.

After this date, anyone who qualified as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the Dearborn City Clerk's office, located at 16901 Michigan Ave., Dearborn, MI 48126 at the following times:

- Regular business hours: Monday-Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Saturday, August 1 from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- Election Day, Tuesday, August 4 from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Additionally, the Dearborn City Clerk's Office will offer voter registration in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the Ford Community & Performing Arts Center, located at 15801 Michigan Ave., Dearborn, MI 48126 at the following times:

- Saturday, July 25 from 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- Sunday, July 26 from 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- Sunday, August 2 from 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

**CITY OF DEARBORN LIBRARY MILLAGE RENEWAL** – Shall the City of Dearborn in accordance with State law MCL §397.201 continue to levy an ad valorem tax not to exceed \$1 per \$1000 in taxable value (1 mill) for no more than 10 years which will be strictly dedicated to fund the operational and capital costs of the library system?
